This six-week course will examine all the factors that led to the fall of the Roman Republic and the Rise of Imperial Rome while drawing timely insights to modern politics in the United States. While there are clear structural and cultural differences between ancient Rome and modern America, patterns of political dysfunction, erosion of norms, and the consolidation of power pose cautionary lessons as we approach a critical national election.

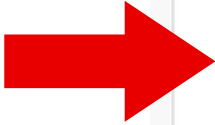

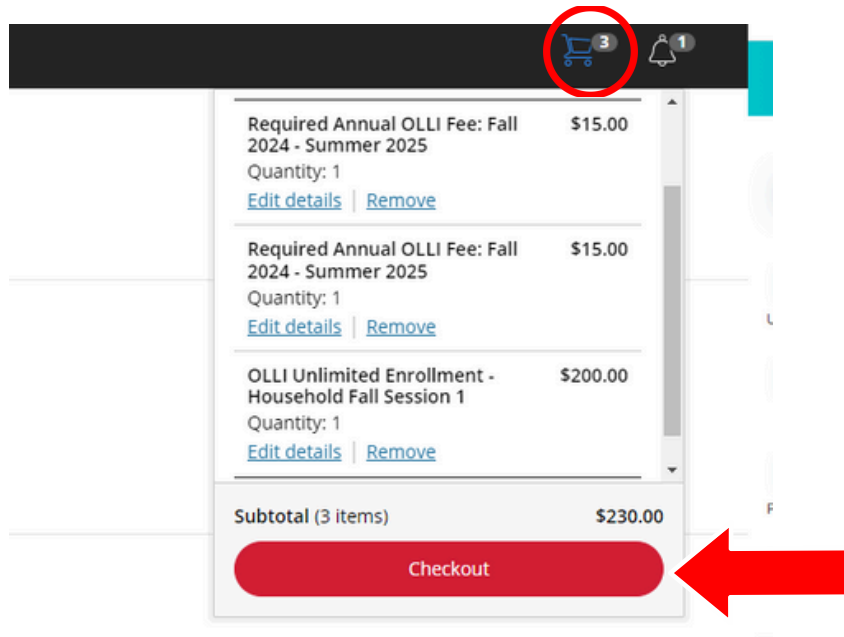
