Meet Elaine Martinez

OLLI members embarked on a rich journey through Portugal, beginning in Lisbon with its historic Alfama district and the grand Jerónimos Monastery. In Belem, they discovered the nation's maritime legacy at iconic monuments and scenic riverside walks. The culinary adventure included sampling traditional pastéis de Belem at renowned local bakeries. The group explored Evora's Roman Temple and Chapel of Bones, delving into the city's layered history. Coastal Nazare offered stunning Atlantic vistas and tales of local fishermen. Sintra's vibrant palaces and lush gardens inspired awe,

while Queluz highlighted the elegant Queluz National Palace. In Porto, members toured the lively Ribeira, Livraria Lello, and renowned wine cellars. Guimaraes, the "cradle of Portugal," impressed with its medieval castle and workshops on national origins. In Braga, the Bom Jesus do Monte sanctuary and ancient squares reflected religious and cultural

diversity. The adventure ended in Aveiro, where picturesque



where picturesque canals and ovos moles pastries provided a sweet finale. Each destination offered unique insights into the country's past and present, leaving members with lasting

memories and a greater appreciation for Portuguese culture.

Free OLLI Open House at Dos Vientos Community Center – December 12th, 2025




