#### **Meet Bev Taylor**

Remember the adage "If you want something done right, ask a busy person."? That is especially true for OLLI student Bev Taylor. Go to the Camarillo Ranch House, she was a docent. Go to the Pleasant Valley Historical Society, Bev is there. Go to the Don & Doña induction, Bev is serving cake. Thankfully, Bev also has time for the OLLI Membership Team, and recently greeted potential OLLI students with Donna Swift at the Camarillo "50 Plus Expo".



Bev was born and raised in San Diego, but some of her most memorable experiences occurred as

this 17-year-old Junior joined her church group on a bus trip from LA to Miami and then on to Albert Schweitzer hospital in Porta Prince, Haiti. She remembers hearing the gunfire at night. With an interest in anatomy, she cared for the sick and had some gruesome tasks with babies.

As a single mother of two young boys, Bev learned to be resourceful with jobs from translating foreign documents at USC to running a check-cashing company in Santa Barbara. Everywhere, she took the initiative, knocked on doors, and made ends meet. She ultimately became the VP for Programs and Teaching at the Arthritis Foundation & the American Diabetes Association.

After raising two boys, Bev married a retired Navy pilot in 2008 and their honeymoon was a Smithsonian private tour around the world in a charter jet for 55 "friends". Ask her about the myriad of stories from Jordon, India, Morocco, Bhutan, and Malawi. Joe died of throat cancer in 2019, leaving her to make a new world for herself again. Today she is active along with several other OLLI friends at the Camarillo Methodist Church, because they were so welcoming. We sure are lucky to have Bev as an OLLI volunteer.
